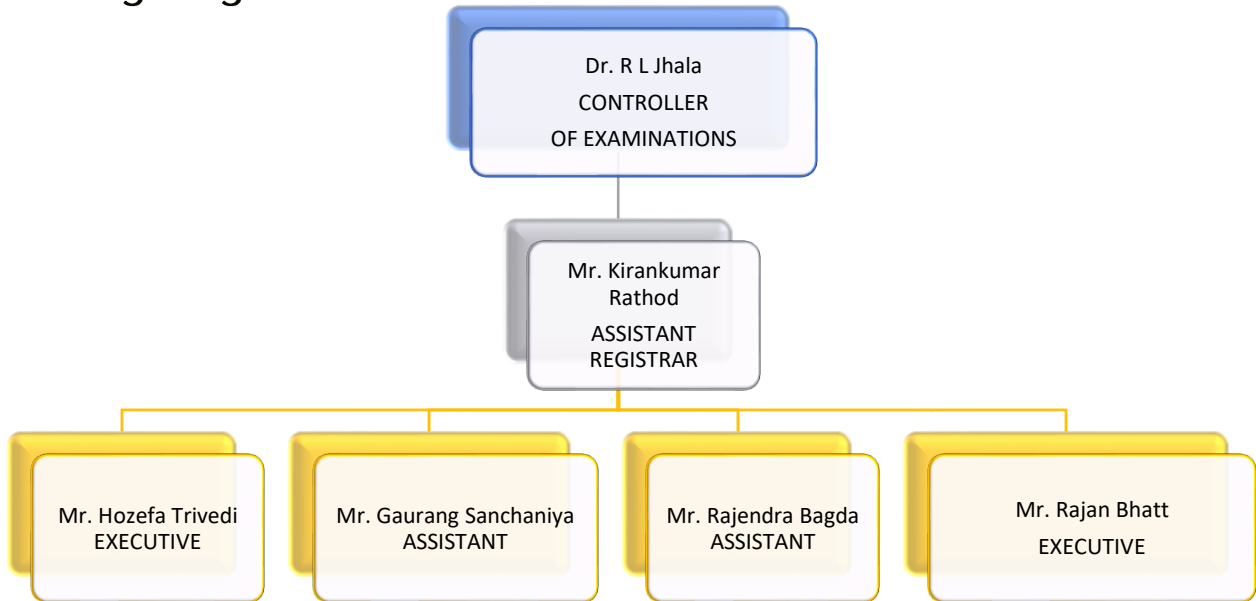

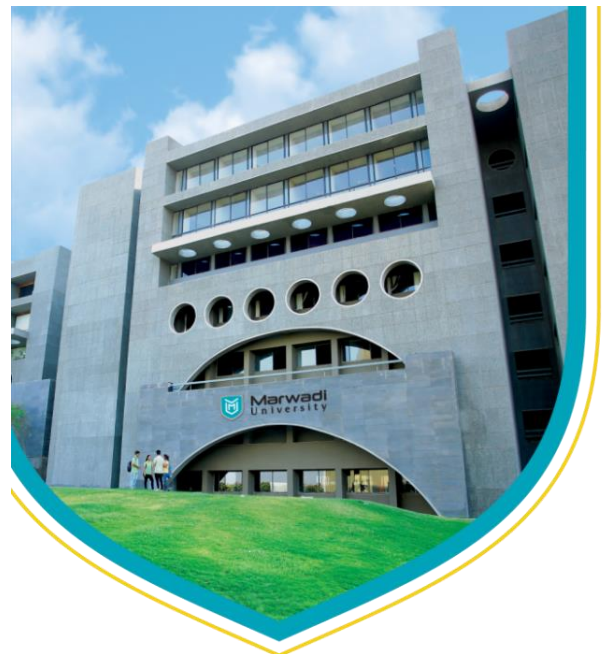


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


INTRODUCTION


As Controller of Examinations of Marwadi University, I am happy to present the annual report of the Examination Department for the Academic Year 2019-20.

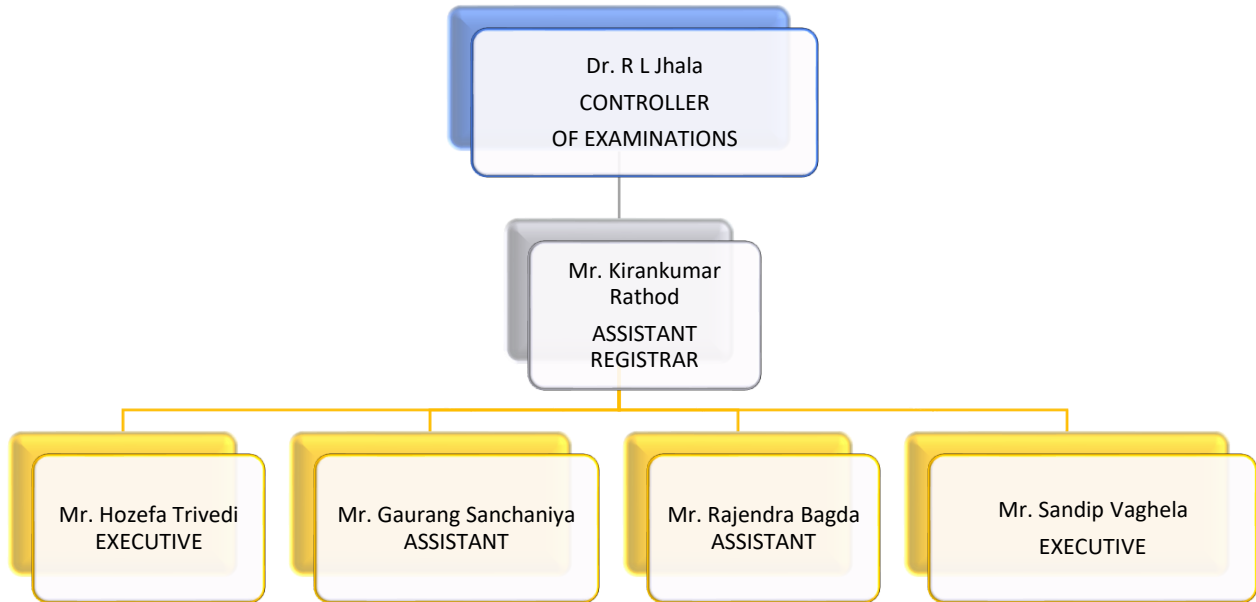

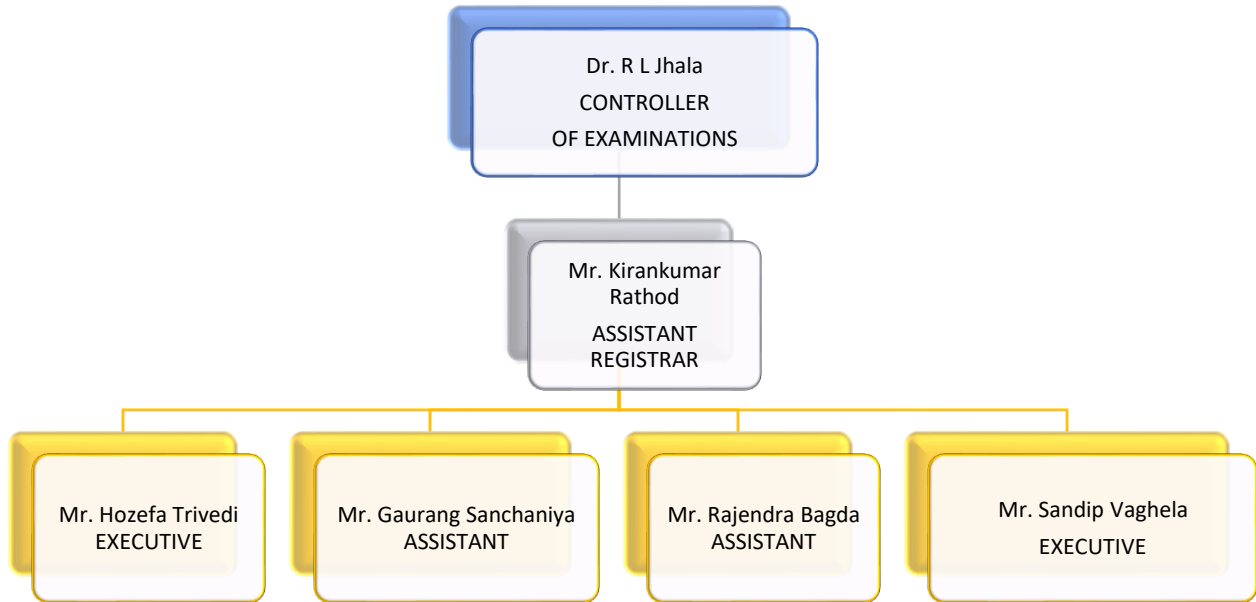


INTRODUCTION

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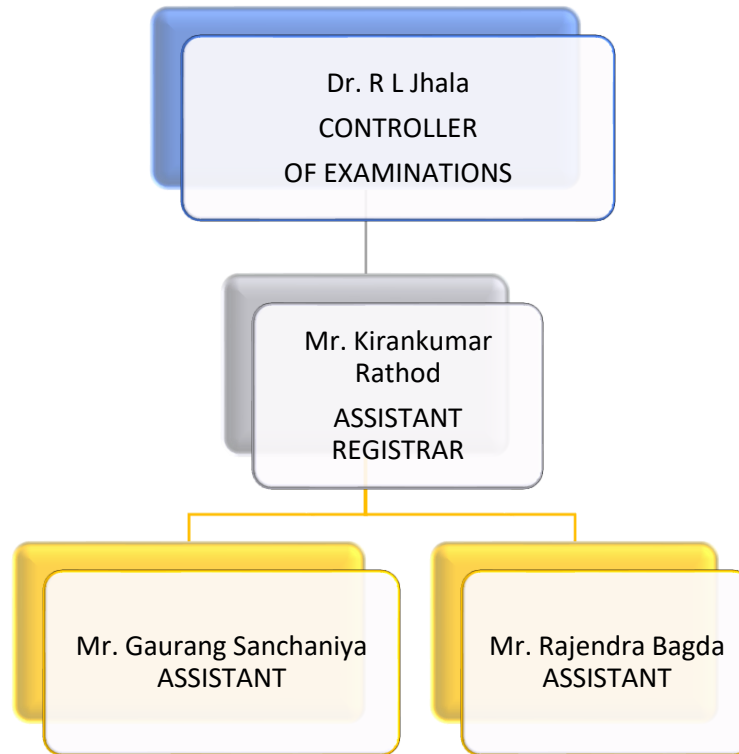

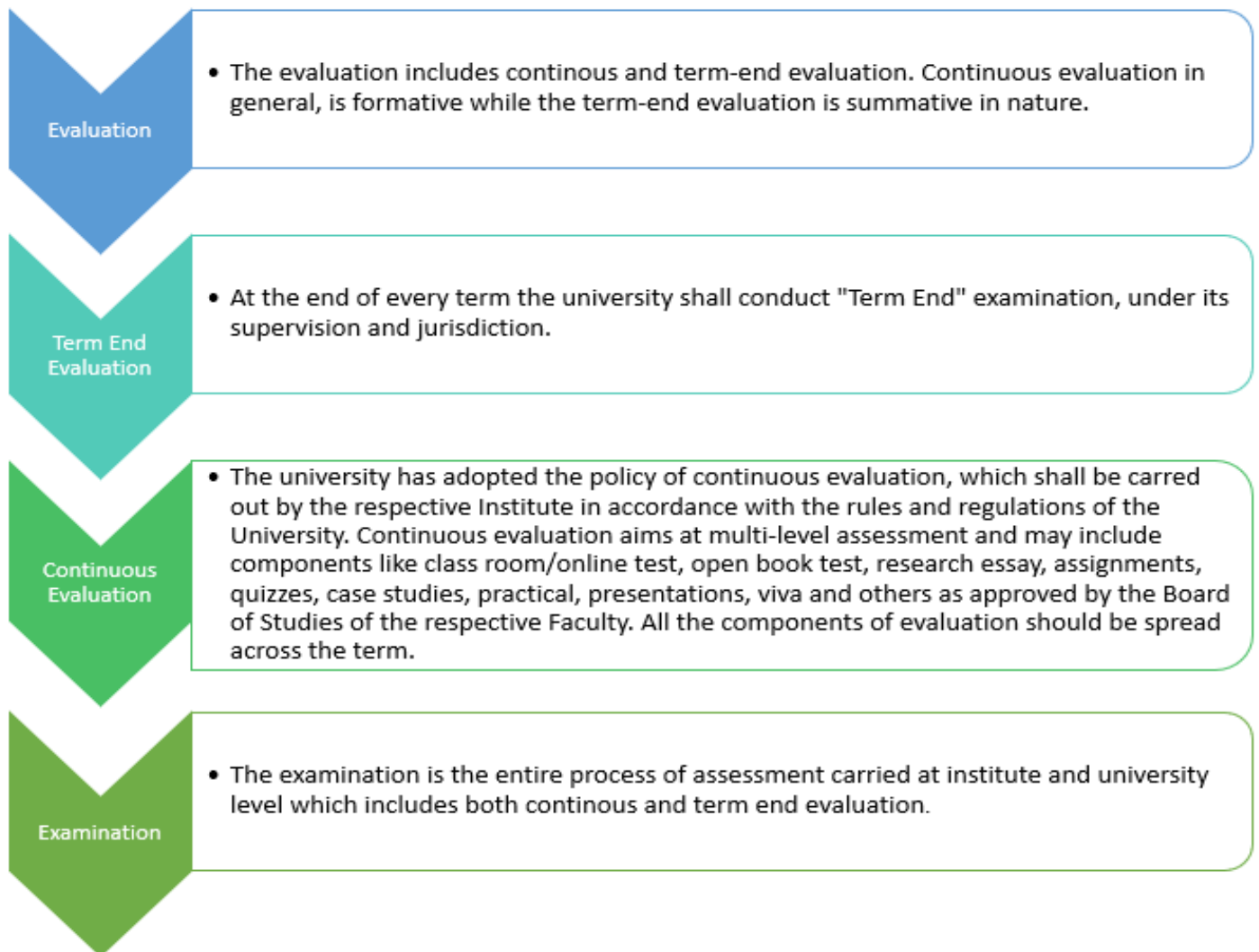

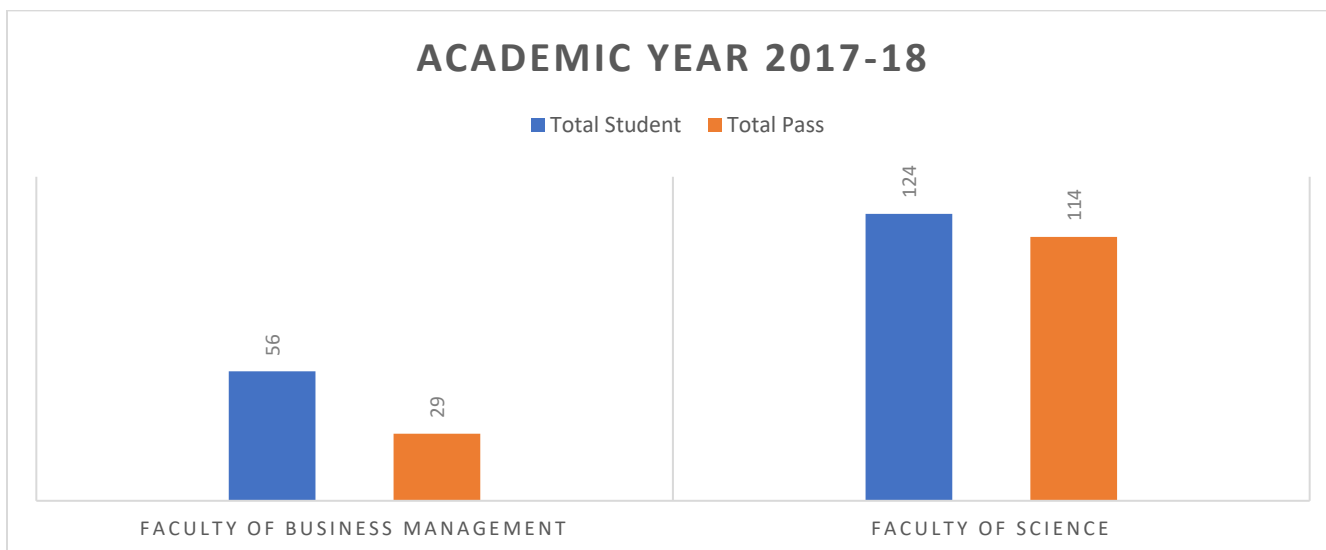

Pass percentage for the Academic Year 2017-18

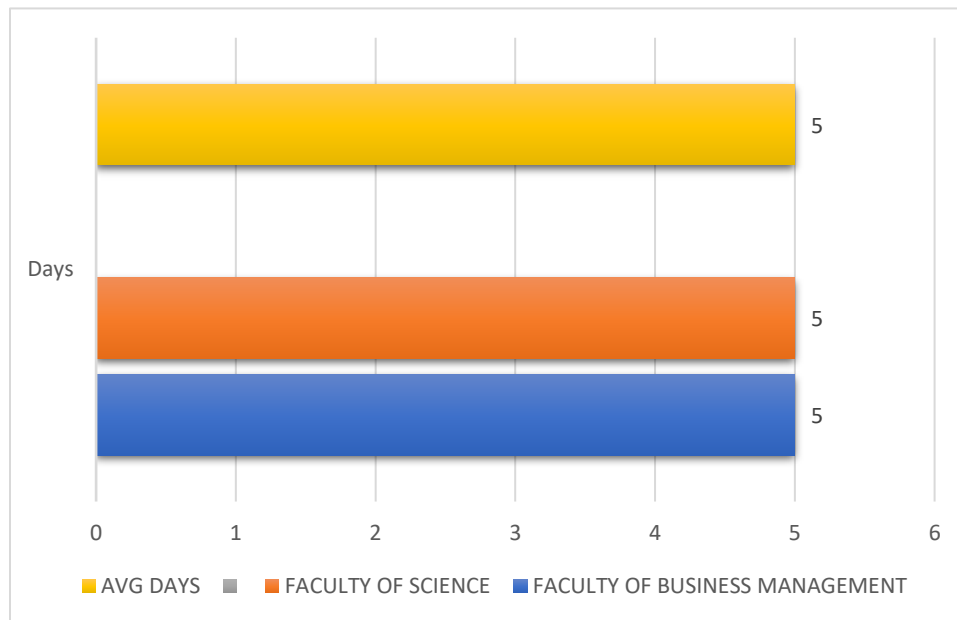

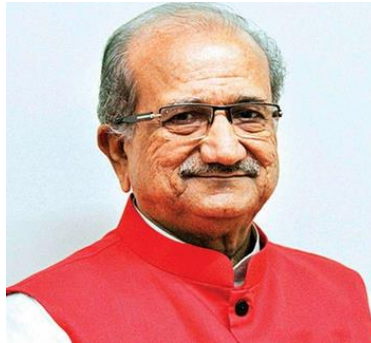
