



#### **Objective:**

• Industrial Visit brings clarity to student's practical experience first-hand how these concepts are put into action.

- It provides an opportunity for students to ask questions related to their area of interest and interact with Chemists and scientists.
- With regular industrial visits, the students are able to identify their prospective area of work like organic synthesis and it's analysis.

Department of chemistry, Faculty of science, Marwadi University has Organized Academic industrial visit For M.Sc. Chemistry semester-3 as a part of their academic curriculum. The visit is organized to Almelo Pvt. Ltd which is one of large production company of API located in Hyderabad and CSIR IICT (Indian Institute of Chemical Technology) which is a national level research centre under the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research. IICT conducts research in basic applied Chemistry, Biochemistry, Bioinformatics and many more.

#### **Visit at Almelo Pvt Ltd**

• The visit helped the students to understand how API (Active Pharmaceutical Ingredient) is manufactured in large scale and gave experience to the sophisticated scientific instruments and research laboratory. Students met several Chemists, known scientists, research scholars and visited sophisticated analytical instrument department. Students have closely observed raw material storage site, Stability chamber, Quality assurance Department, Microbiology Department, water purifying block, Nitrogen production (from atmospheric air) unit and various function instruments such as Far IR, UV







spectrophotometer, polarimeter, Gas Chromatography (GC), Gas Chromatography Mass Spectrometry (GC-MS), Karlfisher, High Performance Liquid Chromatography (HPLC), Fourier Transform Infrared spectroscopy (FTIR), Halogen moisture analyser, TOC (Total Organic Carbon) analyser.

 At last students had a talk with Dr. Keshav Deo an Executive Director of Almelo Pvt Ltd, where student asked their queries and Dr. Deo shared knowledge about recent and current problems regarding health and their possible solutions and many more things.























#### **CSIR IICT** (Indian Institute of Chemical Technology)

The visit gave huge knowledge about sophisticated scientific instruments such as Liquid Chromatography Mass Spectroscopy (LC-MS), Powder XRD (X Ray Diffraction), MALDI, which are helpful in analysis of Chemical compounds.

- Students also got idea that how laboratory idea converted in large production which is one of the important parameter for industries.
- Students also seen National MOL bank which has storage capacity of 60,000 molecules and this process of storage is fully automated and It has sterile atmosphere (Nitrogen atmosphere) with a consistently maintained temperature at around -20°C and round the clock power back-up for molecules stored in vials and tubes in solid or liquid forms.


After a detailed discussion, the attendees agreed to hold the workshop in upcoming semester. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to all attendees.



Bilateral Meeting between Faculty of Law @ Marwadi University (MU) & The National University of Public Service (UPS) @ Ludovika, Budapest (Hungary)

## **Description of the Meeting:**

#### Attendees:

- 1. The Representatives of Both the Institutes met & exchanged Warm Greetings of the Day.
- 2. Faculty of Law @ Marwadi University was represented by:
  - a. Dr. Rhishikesh Dave, Dean, Faculty of Law, MU
  - b. Dr. Dhruv Pande, Associate Professor, Faculty of Law, MU
- 3. The National University of Public Service was represented by:
  - a. Dr. Boglarka Koller, Vice-Rector, International Affairs, UPS
  - b. Dr. Tibor Biro, Dean, Water Science Faculty, UPS
- 4. The Meeting was moderated by: Ms. Hilda Farkas, Counsellor for Science & Technology, Embassy of Hungary

## Nature of the Meeting: Steps towards Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

- A Presentation was made of their respective Institutes: Dr Koller for UPS and Dr Pande for FoL & MU
- 2. A Discussion was held briefly on each of the following aspects:
  - a. Possibility of Joint-Degree/Dual-Degree Program between the two Institutes taking into consideration the Two Different Programs at the Faculty of Law (MU) – B.A.LLB as well as BA (Hons)
  - Joint Research Projects between the Two Institutes on Specialisations offered at each of them viz. Business Law, Human Rights Law, International Law – this would involve LLM & PhD Scholars @ FoL, MU
  - c. Student Exchange Visits Summer School in Hungary & Winter School in India this would involve all Graduate Students @ FoL, MU.

- d. Especially with respect to BA (Hons) 4-year program @ FoL, students would get an opportunity to spend a year @ UPS as part of Ludovika UPS Scholarship for Exchange Students; on a similar pattern as envisaged by 4-year BBA Program @ FoMS, MU
- e. Faculty Exchange Visits A Faculty @ FoL may spend a Semester @ UPS, Budapest for facilitating a Credit-Based Course. This visit will be a part of UPS Ludovika Fellowship to finance a faculty-visit for a Semester @ UPS. Subsequently, the course-work facilitated by FoL Faculty may be made a part of the regular curriculum @ UPS (wherein every semester a Faculty from FoL may facilitate a credit-based course @ UPS)
- f. Organizing International Model United Nations (MUN) in close cooperation with the Two Institutes, as Dr Koller is In-charge (on behalf of the UPS) at the United Nations International Relations Office @ Budapest; this will aid in forging stronger ties between UN as an Institution & Replicating UN Models @ the University-Level.
- g. Furthermore, following avenues of cooperation were discussed in lieu of the following Departments & Institutes at the UPS, to facilitate a cooperation with BA (Hons) at the FoL, MU:
  - (i) Department of Governance and Public Policy @ Faculty of Public Governance and International Studies
  - (ii) Department of International Relations and Diplomacy @ Faculty of Public Governance and International Studies
  - (iii) Institute of National Security (Inter-Faculty Institute @ UPS)
  - (iv) Institute for Strategic Studies (Inter-Faculty Institute @ UPS)
  - (v) Research Institute for Politics and Government @ Eotvos Jozsef Research Centre
  - (vi) Institute for Strategic and Defence Studies @ Eotvos Jozsef Research Centre
- 3. A Masters' Curriculum to be devised on the Theme of "Water Diplomacy & Water Governance" wherein a part of the Masters' may be facilitated in active cooperation with Civil Engineering Department @ Faculty of Engineering, MU and the Water Science Faculty @ UPS
- 4. Thereafter, a brief discussion was held on possibilities of either of the Institutes making a visit to the Other Institute, as & when feasible at their end
- 5. Each of the aforementioned features would be facilitated in hybrid mode of learning & exchange
- 6. It was hence decided to frame an MoU between the Two Institutes, based upon the aforementioned features as guiding parameters for the document
- 7. The Meeting concluded with a Business Lunch hosted by the Embassy of Hungary, taking the discussion further on exchanging information on cultural contexts and extra-curricular aspects of the Two Institutes
- 8. Thus, a decision was arrived upon wherein The Dean, Faculty of Law, Dr. Rhishikesh Dave accepted the kind invitation offered by UPS (Hungary) to meet the Rector, International Affairs @ UPS (Hungary) on 7<sup>th</sup> of June for signing of the MoU between the Two Institutes
