In-depth discussion on rating structure, outcomes and categories under the evaluation were undertaken by the members. The major points of discussion are as below; • Under the rating criteria, major focus of QS I-GAUGE was upon Accreditation (NAAC or NBA) with a weightage of 100 marks. • The meeting suggested that in the current stage we may work

	Conclusion: The meeting agreed upon working towards NAAC & NBA Accreditation in the initial phase and shall apply later for QS I-GAUGE rating.
Discussion on NAAC Self-study Report	The revised Assessment and Accreditation (A&A) framework of NAAC was presented for information of members. Each of the criterions of Quality Indicator Framework (QIF) and its Key Indicators (KIs) were discussed. Members were also informed and briefed about the assessment process consisting of Self Study Report (SSR), Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) and Peer Team Report (PTR). Few important aspects decided in the meeting are as below; Data and track record of each of the passing student shall be maintained and recorded by the Department. Data such as student joining for Higher Studies, Employment Details, Alumni Details etc. should be maintained. Exit feedback of outgoing students should be captured and maintained in the records at the Department
	Conclusion: The members shall study SSR of 2 Universities/Institutes for planning further course of action. Identify and segregate Qualitative & Quantitative data for further working. In the upcoming meeting of Ranking & Rating committee future course of action with assignment of roles and responsibilities of each of the members will be decided.




INAUGURAL SESSION






