
**Report on Expert session on



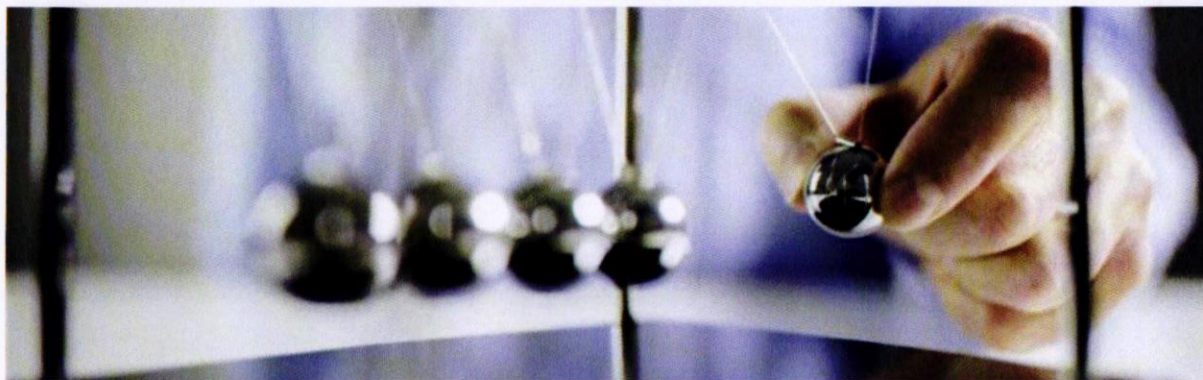


