- That in case any student causes any damage/breakage fully or partially to any property, article, equipment, apparatus which belongs to the University, by mistake or deliberately, the University will have all the rights to recover the damages caused by him/her and impose monetary on him/her, and in case of non payment, University may cancel his/her admission or may take any legal action against him/her.
- That during the entire duration of his/her course he/she will not enroll himself/herself for any other Regular Course in any other University/College/Institution.
- That he/she will neither indulge in any illegal, unlawful or criminal activity, ragging, malpractice, misconduct, fraud nor will get involved in consumption of liquor, drugs, smoking or any other kind of addiction in any manner in the University premises. In case he/she is found indulging in any of the above the University may take any legal action against him/her.
- That he/she would attend the University in prescribed University Uniform and carry and display his/her Identity Card issued by the University, every day, if unable to do so the University can initiate action as per rules and regulations.
- That in case he/she is found traveling in the University Bus without due authorization and permission he/she shall be liable to pay the transport fee of the concerned route for the whole academic year.

Item no.2 - Covid 19 Guidelines

As per the university guidelines dated 5th Nov 2020 for RE-OPENING THE UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES POST LOCKDOWN DUE TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC, the university has decided to take all necessary measures for the protection against Coronavirus.

Generic Preventive Measures/COVID-19 Appropriate Behavior

The following public health measures are to be followed to reduce the risk of COVID-19 by all (faculty members, employees, students and visitors) in these places at all times:

- Physical distancing of at least 6 feet to be followed as far as feasible.
- ii. Use of face covers/masks to be made mandatory.
- iii. Frequent hand washing with soap (for at least 40-60 seconds) even when hands are not visibly dirty. Use of alcohol-based hand sanitizers (for at least 20 seconds) can be done wherever feasible.
- iv. Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue/handkerchief/flexed elbow and disposing of used tissues properly.
- v. Self-monitoring of health by all and reporting any illness at the earliest. vi. Spitting shall be strictly prohibited. vii. Installation & use of Aarogya Setu App shall be advised wherever feasible.

In

- vi. Proper signages, symbols, posters etc. should be prominently displayed at appropriate places to remind the students, faculty and staff of maintaining physical distance. The details of COVID-19 cell established by the institution are prominently displayed containing the emergency number, helpline number, email id and contact details of persons to be contacted in case of any emergency in the institution.
- vii. Ensure the norms of physical distancing, sanitization and hygienic conditions for use of common facilities, viz., Auditorium, Conference/ Seminar halls, Sports, Gymnasium, Canteen, Parking Area etc.
- viii. The faculty, student, staff should be screened regularly to protect and avoid infecting one another.

All preventive measures, preparedness and necessary support systems to deal with the COVID - 19 positive cases should be monitored and reported to local authorities on a day to day basis.

- 1. All smoking, including but not limited to tobacco products and the use of electronic smoking devices, is prohibited in enclosed buildings and facilities and during indoor or outdoor events on the campus.
- 2. Harassment on the basis of any legally protected characteristic is a form of discrimination and is likewise prohibited by this university policy. Prohibited harassment occurs if a hostile environment has been created that is sufficiently severe, pervasive, or persistent so as to unreasonably interfere with a person's work performance or participation in university activities.

Prohibited harassment may take the form of (but is not limited to) offensive slurs, jokes, and other offensive oral, written, computer-generated, visual or physical conduct which is aimed at an individual or group because of their protected status.



The committee has decided to take strict action against the students for any kind of misconduct.

Item no. 4 - No Tobacco Guidelines - TOBACCO FREE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION

Adequate number of signage for all to see and understand the implication of consuming tobacco. The signage to be in the language of the Institution (English) and in the local language as well.

Innovation or adapting the display according to the capacity and content should convey the correct intended message like street play and nukkad natak.

It is to be noted that the Head of the Institution is also authorized to collect fine for violation of section 6(b), sale of tobacco products within 100 yards of an educational institution.

All the security staff, Hostel Warden and other Heads will also monitor that even tobacco substitutes such as e-cigarettes and the like devices viz. Heat-not-Burn devices, Vape, e-Sheesha, e-Nicotine flavored hookah is not used in the campus.


Aptitude for innovation

The session was concluded by vote of thanks by Dr. Krishna Joshi and Dr. Vicky Jain again welcomed the new students.


