MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

MARWADI UNIVERSITY, RAJKOT

AND

ALMELO PRIVATE LIMITED, HYDERABAD



This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on the 10th January, 2022.

I. PREAMBLE

Whereas, Marwadi University, Rajkot is a State Private University established under the Government of Gujarat Private University act 9 of 2016 on 9th May, 2016. Marwadi University is promoted by Marwadi Education Foundation's Group of Institution established in 2008 by Marwadi Shares and Finance Limited a major stock broking company in India & Chandarana Intermediaries Brokers Pvt. Ltd. a leading firm dealing in technical and arbitrage trading in Indian Stock Market.

In order to enhance human capabilities, contribute knowledge & skill to augment human life and provide immense opportunities to every individual to discover his true potential, the Marwadi University has established nine institutes, which are: Faculty of Engineering, Faculty of Technology, Faculty of Science, Faculty of Management, Faculty of Liberal Studies, Faculty of Law, Faculty of Computer Application, Faculty of Pharmacy and Faculty of Physiotherapy.

Whereas, Almelo Private Limited is research-intensive manufacturing unit of API and its intermediates, design and development and consultancy in the field of pharmaceuticals.

Marwadi University (herein after referred to as "MU") and Almelo Private Limited (herein after referred to as "APL") is collectively referred, as "the Parties" or individually as "Party."

Whereas, both MU and Almelo Private Limited now

- Recognizing the importance of Skill Development, Entrepreneurship, Startup and Research & Development in the areas of healthcare and pharma sectors as well as imparting industrial training to the students, etc.
- Desiring to club their efforts by pooling their expertise and resources

Intend to form a center for promoting excellent quality manpower in the fields of science and technology with special emphasis on Drug Discovery Development, pharma intermediates and related fields etc.



II. SCOPE

This MoU sets forth the intention of the Parties for increased collaboration, cooperation and interaction and does not create any legally binding commitments. If the Parties later agree to undertake specific joint projects with legally binding obligation, they will develop separate written agreements for such projects, setting out each Party's contribution, deliverables, and budgets.

III. TERMS OF INTERACTIONS

Both MU and APL shall encourage interactions between the Scientists, Engineers, Research fellows, Faculty members and Students of both the organizations through the following arrangements:

- a) Exchange of personnel through deputation as per the rules of the respective organization, for limited periods as mutually agreed upon
- b) Jointly Organize conferences, workshop and seminars
- c) Practical training of MU students at APL
- d) Introduction of Skill based training by Learning and Development team MU
- e) Designing of course curriculum.
- f) Facilitating employment to the students post achieving certification.
- g) Joint guidance of student projects/thesis in Chemistry and other areas of national interest at MU by APL on mutually agreeable terms.
- h) APL would accommodate M. Sc. students who have completed the 2nd semester of their programme in such a number that APL deems convenient to it for the purpose of imparting industrial training.
- i) APL may depute its personnel as visiting faculty at MU to teach any of the regular course or specialized topics.
- j) APL personnel, as well as research scholars, may also be allowed to enroll for their Ph.D. at MU, subject to availability of seats, research facilities and subject to their fulfilling eligibility criteria and all other academic regulations of MU. Further, APL may request to design and teach a Course or Courses which it deems fit to enhance quality and performance of its employees. Such Courses maybe run at any mutually convenient premises.
- k) APL may seek assistance/guidance of MU faculty member/s in product/process modification, modernization, trouble shooting, etc.
- l) Would allow the industrial visits of students for half/full day to provide them with an exposure to various equipment, instrument, etc.
- m) APL may showcase its business activities at the seminar/ workshop/ conference, etc. at MU.
- n) APL may avail library, Internet, computational facilities at MU.
- o) The student maybe encouraged to take up the project such that APL desirably benefits from its outcomes.



- p) The students will carry out part of their Ph.D. research work or M. Sc. dissertation/project at MU and APL depending on the nature of the work as per rules of the respective organization depending on facilities and requirements.
- q) There will be no restriction on the contents of the thesis and on publication of results of the thesis, subject to the condition that no Intellectual Property Rights can be secured for any part of the work which will be decided with mutual consent.
- r) Both MU and APL will be free to independently carry out follow-up research on the thesis work conducted under this scheme.
- s) If the outcome of a project related to product development, process technology and design etc. which involves matter of secrecy and concern with security of the State and the Country, the same will not be allowed for publication/printing in any form such as Electronically/verbal, etc. If the outcome of a project results into an intellectual property, for which rights can be secured, it will be decided on case to case basis. Similarly, sharing of expenditure in securing such rights and income accrued through royalty etc by the parties under the law will be decided on case to case basis after mutual consultation.
- t) In any of the activities mentioned above, wherever financial aspects are involved, amount, payment conditions, etc. would be spelt out clearly before starting the activity.

IV. SHARING OF FACILITIES

- a) MU and APL shall make provisions to share their respective important R&D facilities and other allied infrastructure in order to promote academic and research interaction in the areas of cooperation.
- b) MU and APL shall permit the sharing software and other materials and components developed in-house in the areas of cooperation, if permissible within the rules governing the two organization. However, responsibility for safety of software and other materials during the exchange will rest on respective Head of academic department/section.
- c) MU and APL shall provide access to the library facilities to students, researcher and faculty members as per the prevailing rules and norms in the respective APL and MU.

V. CO-ORDINATION OF THE PROGRAMME INCLUDING FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- a) The collaborative programme between MU and APL shall be coordinated by a coordination committee appointed by Registrar/Managing Director of MU and APL.
- b) Financial arrangements for each specific collaboration will be decided on a case-to-case basis and brought on record in each case after due approval from heads of MU and APL.



VI. DURATION

This MoU shall be effective for a period of two years from the date of MoU. It may be modified or extended by mutual written agreement by the Parties. This MoU may be terminated by either Party upon six months advance written notice.

VII. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Rights regarding publications, patents, copyrights, royalty, ownership of software/design/product developed etc. under the scope of this MOU, shall be decided by the two parties by mutual consent.

VIII. AMENDMENTS

No amendments can be made to this MoU without written consent and duly signed by both the Parties. Document containing such additions, deletions/alterations shall be signed by both the Parties and shall form addenda to this MoU and be deemed to be part of this MoU.

IX. CONFIDENTIALITY

Each Party undertakes to observe the confidentiality and secrecy of documents, information and other data received from, or supplied to the other Party during the period of the implementation of the MoU or any other agreements made pursuant to this MoU.

X. MONITORING

Implementation of the MoU will be jointly monitored by MU and APL.

XI. SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

This MoU is not intended to create any legal obligations between the Parties. Any difference or dispute between the Parties concerning the interpretation and/ implementation of any of the provision of this MoU shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/ or negotiations between the Parties through diplomatic channels and without reference to any third party or tribunal.

XII. MISCELLANEOUS

- a) The MoU as outlined in this document is not intended to be a legally binding document. Rather, it is meant to describe the nature and cooperative intention of MU and APL to suggest guidelines for cooperation. Nothing, therefore, shall diminish the full autonomy of either party, nor may any constraints be imposed by either upon the other, and nothing



in this MoU shall be deemed to create a partnership, joint venture, or agency relationship between the parties.

- b) Both MU and APL shall not, during the term of this Agreement directly or indirectly, solicit or offer employment or engagement to any of the personnel of other party without the prior consent in writing of that other party.
- c) The use of the name, logo and/or official emblem of any of the parties on any publication, document and/or paper is allowed only, after seeking explicit prior permission in writing by either party.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual promises made herein and of good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which both MU and APL hereby acknowledge, MU and APL hereby agree to sign a memorandum of understanding (MOU).

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

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding has been made and agreed upon between the parties mentioned below, signed on 15-07-2021 by and between the following two entities collectively referred to as "Parties" and each referred to individually as "Party".

Marwadi University hereinafter referred to as "Marwadi University" having its registered office at Marwadi University, Rajkot-Morbi Highway, Rajkot, Gujarat, 360003, India, represented by Dr. Lalji Baldaniya, Principal, Faculty of Pharmacy, Marwadi University, after called as "First Party" which expression shall, where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors, executors and administrators of the FIRST PARTY

AND

Life Sciences Sector Skill Development Council (LSSSDC), a Sector Skill Council set up by the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) working under the aegis of Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE) for the Skill development initiatives in Banking, Financial Services and Insurance Sector across the country, functioning from its head office 14th Palam Marg, Vasant Vihar, New Delhi - 110057 acting through **Mr. Ranjit Madan - CEO**, LSSSDC Sector Skill Council of India (hereinafter referred to as "LSSSDC" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, includes its successor in office, legal representatives and permitted assigns) of the SECOND PARTY

WHEREAS Marwadi University would be taking steps for the implementation of relevant programmes, mutually decided by both the parties, which would aim to enhance the employability of students by equipping them with industry-relevant skills.

AND WHEREAS, LSSSDC through its Education & Skill Development initiatives will work closely with its members and Industry Associates to help improve the quality of the employable skills of students of Marwadi University. In this regard, there are various Technical and Non-Technical courses undertaken to meet this objective.

Now it is hereby mutually agreed amongst both parties to this MoU and binds themselves to the terms and conditions enumerated in succeeding paragraphs/Annexures-A and B.

Background

National Skill Development Policy 2015 mandated a tremendous growth plan in order to bridge the skill gaps by complementing the vocational education system through conducting research, improving the delivery mechanism, assuring quality etc. to identify skill development needs, maintain skill inventory, planning & execution of training of trainers through the development of IT-enabled Labor Management Information System (LMIS).

The Indian life-sciences sector has seen a growth of 7.61 percent CAGR over the last 5 years (FY14FY19). The Life-sciences sector, segmented into pharmaceuticals, biopharmaceuticals and contract research, with large Indian and MNC companies along with a number of medium and small companies together comprising of approximately 8000 active companies. A majority of Industrial units are concentrated in the clusters in western and southern parts of the country. Make in India, Ayushman Bharat, recently announced API and medical device package and Biotechnology Clusters would be impacting the growth positively. The sector is currently employing a 9.03 Lacs workforce and expected to create 1.70 Lacs new opportunity till 2022 in an optimal growth scenario, despite the COVID-19 pandemic.

Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) in their circular Ref No. 14-260/2014-PCI/4486 dated 30th of September includes LSSSDC QPs as elective subjects for skill packs for B. Pharma (Semester- VIII) candidates.

This MoU with LSSSDC aid skill development in line with industry-focused Job Roles. This will enhance employment opportunities for freshers in Life Sciences (Pharma, Bio-Pharma, CRO & Ayush) Industries.

Scope of Work

- a. Marwadi University will provide support for skill development activities with a joint association of LSSSDC. LSSSDC will facilitate the skilling process within its boundaries of function.
- b. Marwadi University can select any of the following Job Roles as electives for VIII Semester B. Pharma Candidates
 - i. Production Manufacturing Chemist
 - ii. Quality Control Chemist
 - iii. Medical Sales Representative(Note: If college want to add any other Job Role, college need to take prior permission from LSSSDC)
- c. Training of Trainers will be provided by LSSSDC to identified faculty of Marwadi University.
- d. Study Material (Books/E-Books) for various Job Roles is available with LSSSDC, Marwadi University will inform their requirements in advance to LSSSDC.
- e. Option for E-Skilling by Industry experts is available with LSSSDC and can be provided on the requirement.
- f. Assessment of the enrolled candidates shall be conducted by LSSSDC based on its norms of National Skills Qualification Framework (NSQF) based Assessments Guidelines.

- g. LSSSDC will facilitate Placement/Apprenticeship to successful assessed and certified candidates.

1. Roles and Responsibility

The principal roles and responsibilities of the parties will be as set out in Annexure-A.

2. Parties Shall

- a. Not use other party's Intellectual Property unless such other party consents to such use.
- b. Not do anything which in the reasonable opinion of the other party is or will be harmful to the reputation of the other party.
- c. Keep each other informed of any matters relevant to the overall functioning.
- d. Share their expertise or any other information which would be of mutual benefit.

3. Financial Terms and Conditions

- a. Marwadi University will pay the assessment fees as per prevailing charges.
- b. Marwadi University will pay Training of Trainers fees as per prevailing charges.
- c. Marwadi University will pay the cost for books/e-books.
- d. Marwadi University will pay fees for online training/webinars as per the requirement.
- e. All fees to be paid before the said activity in advance to LSSSDC

4. Duration/ Term of the MoU

- a. The MoU shall begin from the date of its execution by the parties hereto.
- b. This MoU shall continue in full force and effect up to 5 years from the date of signing i.e. up to 14-07-2026.
- c. The validity of this MoU shall be extended sufficiently early for further periods/batches on mutual agreement by the parties to the MoU.
- d. This Memorandum of Understanding is a document of good faith and Implementation of the MoU would be monitored on a six-monthly basis.

5. Termination

- a. Either party may terminate this MoU by mutual understanding by giving 3 (three) months' notice in writing served on the other.
- b. The parties to the MoU understand that, where a course, as aforesaid, is under continuance, the termination shall take effect only on completion of the subsisting course.

- c. Save as otherwise set out in this MoU, the termination of this MoU howsoever arising is without prejudice to the rights, duties and liabilities of either party accrued prior to termination.

6. Confidentiality

- a. Each party hereto agrees with the other:
- To keep information in strict confidence and secrecy.
 - Not to use the information save for complying with its obligations under this MoU.
 - Not to disclose the same to a third party other than the party's professional advisers and such employees of the other party on a need to know basis as per requirements of this MoU, who are under a similar duty to protect confidential information, or any third party having a legal right to obtain disclosure thereof.
- b. The restrictions contained in the above clause shall apply to both the parties during the term of and for (one) year after the termination of this MoU but shall cease to apply to information or knowledge which:
- Has in it's entirely become public knowledge otherwise than through any unauthorised disclosure or other breaches of such restriction.
 - The other party has consented in writing to the same being disclosed.
 - Is or has been independently developed by the other party without reference to or use of the confidential information.
 - Each party designates the Nodal officer to arrange the needed facility Dr. Lalji Baldaniya, Principal, Faculty of Pharmacy, Marwadi University from FIRST party and Dr. Deepak Barot, Cluster Head – Western and Central Zone, LSSSDC.

7. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes and differences whatsoever arising under or in connection with this MoU which could not be settled by parties through negotiations, after the period of thirty (30) working days from the service of the notice, shall be finally settled by arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the Amendment Act 2013. The parties will refer for a sole arbitrator to be appointed by the parties in consultation with each other. The place of arbitration shall be in New Delhi.

Upon approval by each party, this agreement will remain in effect for the period of 5 years, unless terminated earlier by either institution.

Notwithstanding the above, the period of this co-operation will, if necessary be extended with consent in writing from the parties.

- 2.3 The subject will be of 4 credit as per Marwadi University norms. The Evaluation of the subject will be conducted at the end of semester/programme as per guide line of Marwadi University. The performance evaluation components will consist of minimum of 80 % attendance, idea pitching and project report submission. Attendance of the participants will be attested by Registrar of Marwadi University.
- 2.4 Performance of the participants will be evaluated by Marwadi University in 100 marks out of which 40 marks for idea pinching and 60 marks for Project Report submission. The certificates will be awarded to successful trainees jointly by CED & Marwadi University after meeting the required criteria.
- 3 Marwadi University has to provide hand holding support to trainees after completion of program. The hand holding support will include providing counseling on business opportunity, assist in preparation of project proposal/report, guidance for government schemes/benefits, loan related documentation, helping in securing bank loan and government subsidies, mentoring during the startup phase.
